PIRATE GUILD/GROUP and ENTERTAINMENT REQUIREMENTS

All Pirate Guilds and Groups ("Guilds") or Entertainment, either solo or group ("Entertainment") in attendance must abide with the Requirements as outlined in this Application to receive entry by either ticket or wristband* at the discretion of Event Coordinators. A Representative of the Guild or Entertainment must read and sign their acceptance (bottom on page 3). *A limited amount of 21+ Admission Wristbands will be given to each Guild. Extra wristbands can be purchased from Event Sponsors for \$15/each.

PARTICIPATION:

- Guilds must participate in Pirate Festival Activities from the beginning of the Festival until the end providing education, entertainment (within their group), and/or games (family/kids Pirate games are encouraged)
- Guilds must have an open common area in their encampment for the public to come and experience it.
- Entertainment will be provided a Stage and a Schedule by Event staff. Guilds and Entertainment must provide assistance to Pirate Festival as outlined below.
 - Meet & Greet the attendees at Ticket Booths (1 hour)
 - Man the SCVBREWMASTERS information booth (1 hour)
 - Check wristbands for Entrance to SCVBREWMASTER Pirate Beer Tasting area (1 hour)
- Encampment must be set up and ready to operate, with no non-period décor items showing when gates open.
- All weapons must be sheathed and peace-tied at all times. NO firearms allowed.
- Alcoholic beverages are not allowed anywhere at the Event. Beer Tasting allowed in SCVBREWMASTERS Beer Tasting area ONLY. No drinking of alcoholic beverages in Encampment area.

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GUILD AND ENTERTAINMENT SCHEDULES;

- Guilds are expected to participate and interact actively with the public during the entirety of the Event.
- Entertainment is expected to be on stage at their scheduled time and when not on stage to interact with public.

FIRE INSPECTION: Guilds must have in their encampment a fire extinguisher with a minimum rating of 2A10B:C AND must bear a tag with the servicing information.

PARKING: The Main Parking Lot is for Patrons ONLY. There is a designed area for Vendors and Guilds and Entertainment to park. Please provide any special requests for parking to Event in writing.

SITE PLAN: Let us know a suggested space size ASAP. We will assign the actual space you will be allotted. Your site plan will need to be drawn within the allotted space, mailed or e-mailed back to me by July 9, 2021. We will submit your plans to the Fire Dept. to be approved. Please show the entrance and give the dimensions of your allotted guild space and location of fire extinguishers. You must remain within the boundaries set by Event.

SET-UP: Friday Saturday Sept. 18th 7:00am – 9am. – *ALL VEHICLES MUST BE OUT OF THE AREA NO LATER THAN 9:00 AM DAY OF EVENT- NO EXCEPTIONS.* If you need more time for set-up, we can schedule some time on Friday, Sept. 17.

BREAKDOWN: Saturday, Sept. 18th Breakdown / Clean-up 5:00pm – 8:00pm. Absolutely no breakdown of encampments or vehicles allowed into the Festival grounds **until after 5pm**. If you bring your vehicle onto the Event site after Breakdown, drive carefully and safely. Back Entry on

CLEAN-UP: *ALL* garbage generated by Guild/Entertainment MUST be placed in the Dumpsters, NO EXCEPTIONS. DO NOT use the Festivaltrash cans! Your area m ust be left clean or you may be banned from further participation.
